**TASTING NOTES** Our 2023 Calesa Chardonnay makes a vibrant and expressive debut, shining in the glass with a brilliant golden-yellow hue. A lively bouquet bursts forth with aromas of Meyer lemon, crisp green apple, and fresh lime zest, gracefully layered with hints of pineapple and young mango. The palate is defined by a bright, energetic acidity that carries focused flavors of Granny Smith apple and zesty citrus from start to finish. As the wine unfolds, delicate notes of honeysuckle emerge alongside the faintest, most graceful hint of creamy texture—a nod to its thoughtful barrel aging—which adds complexity without sacrificing the wine's refreshing core. This leads to a clean, balanced, and persistent finish, leaving a lasting impression of coastal purity and sophistication.

**VINEYARD NOTES** We are thrilled to introduce the inaugural vintage of our Calesa Vineyard Chardonnay, a new chapter born from our deep-rooted partnership with this exceptional site. Since 2015, we have trusted the meticulous farming of owner Oscar Renteria for our Pinot Noir, and we are now proud to showcase his Chardonnay. Located in the heart of the Petaluma Gap, the vineyard is defined by persistent coastal wind and fog that allow the grapes to ripen slowly, developing remarkable flavor concentration while preserving the vibrant, energetic acidity that makes this location so special. The result is a wine that purely expresses the tension and beauty of its dramatic cool-climate origins.
